Ratings: Tales Of Two Cities

A Country Aircheck analysis of Fall 2021 Nielsen diary ratings winners found two stations succeeding in two cities each. Star Of The Shows: Wheeler WSLC/Roanoke, VA "Star Country 94.9" jumped nearly three shares in the Fall book (7.4)

to 10.2) for its best showing in two-and-ahalf years. While the cities of Roanoke and Lynchburg were combined into one market decades ago, VP/GM/PD Brett Sharp explains the two, which are an hour apart, might as well still be separate markets.

"When we do our library test, half of it is Roanoke, and half is Lynchburg," says Sharp, who has been with the station since it signed on in 2000. "Some songs test better in Roanoke than Lynchburg and vice

versa, so sometimes the outliers get kicked out. The music is first and foremost; I'm grateful to work for a mom-and-pop that still believes in spending money to test music."

"We also have the familiarity factor," adds Sharp. "We're not a 'new country' or 'young country' station. We play currents and recurrents, and we go a little deeper [with gold], based on research. 'Dust On The Bottle' and 'Fishin' In The Dark' test for [both markets, so] we still play those songs."

WSLC's 45% gold content doesn't mean Sharp isn't bullish on new music, explaining, "I'm grateful when Nashville sends artists that can help us connect with the youth. I'm hopeful for the next Taylor Swift, whoever that is, to bring younger people to the format."

Sharp also points out an additional music tactic last fall: "Our sister AC [WSLQ] goes all Christmas, so to try and retain some of our listeners, we stacked up [Christmas titles]. We didn't go all Christmas, but we treated them like our best testing songs. You couldn't go a quarter hour on Star Country without hearing a Christmas sona."

"There's not one person who programs Star Country – it's the team," adds Sharp. That includes Nathan "Boomer" Hatcher in mornings, Taylor Sherrill in middays and Kevin **Scott** in afternoons. (continued on page 7)


Studio2Bee Expands

Last month's staff additions (CAT 2/14, 2/16) mark a significant expansion for Studio2Bee principals Skip Bishop and Butch Waugh. They and new EVP/GM Glenn

Noblit explain the eight-yearold company's growth.

"The way Studio2Bee started was both Skip and I were constantly approached by industry leaders for advice, input and opinions," Waugh says. "It quickly morphed into more meeting requests and

offers to be compensated for our contributions. It organically became a business with multiple income streams."

Country Aircheck goes Off The Record with Big Loud's Ernest:

I balance being a father and husband with my career by prioritizing being as present as possible during my time at home. Time management is everything.

I grew up listening to [AC WJXA], [Adult Hits WCJK] and [Urban WUBT], then [Top 40 WRVW] and Country stations WSIX and WSM-FM in Nashville.

The first time I heard myself on the radio, I was driving by my high school baseball field on my way home — normal shortcut — and it popped up on [WKDF/Nashville] ... surreal timing. I'll never forget it.

"Flower Shops" is the story of a good love that just about got gone for good ... the song *and* the album. This guy has run out of apologies.

I wish I'd written John Mayer's "Why You No Love Me." Incredible chords, melody and lyrics. He is a genius.

My favorite song on the radio right now is ... "Flower Shops" [laughs].

I'm always bingeing Curb Your Enthusiasm and Family Guy and currently the Kanye docuseries on Netflix.

Radio can expect more of everything from me in 2022. Stay tuned.

Over the last two years, Studio2Bee solidified its customized implementation of artist development, promotion and marketing plans on behalf of clients. "The pandemic has really defined who we are, because we were a little ahead of the curve in our approach," Bishop says. "It happened organically – we didn't expect this influx of new business. We went from four clients, to seven, to 12 and said, 'Let's go hire the best staff in this town.' We did countless interviews and, when Glenn became available, we were very happy."

A long-tenured label promotion vet, Noblit appreciated Studio2Bee's out-of-the-box thinking. "I've always admired Butch and Skip," he says. "We share a passion for music and artist development, and their company is on the front line of how music is evolving and changing. We aren't tied to an old-school mentality where a release schedule drives the project. We look for different ways to make things happen."


Noblit now oversees a staff of three, including Sr. Dir./National Promotion **Chris Waters**, SVP/Artist Development & Marketing **Jenn Littleton** and Sr. Dir./National Modern Media & Creative **Kylee Laynee Higgins**.

Unlike most label or label services deals, Studio2Bee generally works on retainer. "We made a conscious decision not to tap into the artists' revenue drivers – streaming, publishing, touring, merch," Waugh says. "Not that we couldn't do that kind of deal if the artist wanted that structure." Bishop adds, "We also don't take clients on if they don't have backing. We aren't interested in taking money they would use to pay rent and feed their family. If we really like an artist who doesn't, we may work with them pro bono until we can help them find backing."

Once a client is on board, the team works with the artist to assemble a timeline and path they refer to as the "Launch & After Launch Plan." Adjustments and unforeseen opportunities

are addressed along the way. As for radio, Studio2Bee is not singularly focused on airplay. "It goes beyond that to tapping into programmers' knowledge, experience and market awareness," Waugh says. "They can advise how the artist and music fits into their market's opportunities. Two things we know, programmers know more about their markets than we do and the artist knows more about their fans than we do." Adds Noblit, "Relationships are even more important than they used to be, and that's radio but also DSPs. And that helps us read the tea leaves on trends, breakouts and what's happening even on a regional scale."

The company also compiles a custom "Studio2Bee Air Report" for client artists and labels. "We take music to 15-20 of the best decisions makers – mostly radio – who know we're not coming to beat them up for airplay," Bishop explains. "Their input – sometimes brutally honest – along with our number-crunching can help determine the best of

three songs to approach with at radio and DSPs."

Clients aren't just artists and labels. "We've had deals with Comcast, publishers including Big Yellow Dog, and Sony and Warner in Canada," Bishop says. "We also work in pop, AAA and Americana." Sums Noblit, "We're very open minded and flexible. If there's compelling music, we will find a way to expose it."





Beyond music and personalities, Sharp is keen on keeping WSLC visible. "The pandemic didn't help, but we didn't stop marketing. We still pay money to build cume. We did some targeted television spots to try and create appointment listening, and we still do some billboards. The world is opening, and we are ready. We're getting new tents, roll banners and other stuff to help brand our stations. We've got fulltime, 20-plus-year-tenured staff, and they're ready to go out and work weekends to keep us No. 1."

Cheesehead Of The Class: In Appleton, WI, Midwest WNCY "Y100" scored its best book in five years with a 9.1 to 11.6 jump while pulling double digit shares in Green Bay. "It really is kind of a balancing act, because we do have two Nielsen markets," says PD Dan Stone. "Normally, we're No. 1 in Appleton and sometimes first – [but] most often second – in Green Bay. We are licensed to Neenah, which would be the Appleton market, but our studios are in Green Bay." That naturally

brings up a popular local football team: "We are not the Packers station [Sister Top 40 WIXX carries the games], but it does provide a lot of great on-air fodder."

"One thing we missed [during COVID] was the face-to-face interaction with the listeners," laments Stone. "That's how this station was built. We used to do promotions like the 'Hometown Handshake,' and those are just starting to come back now. We try to do promotions that everybody can listen to and enjoy. The 'Secret Sound' is our signature on-air promotion almost every book. We also do a thousand dollar one-second-song every

morning at 7:30. We kept that going right though COVID, even though budgets were tight."

With sister station **WGEE** airing Classic Country, WNCY's music is under 40% gold. "We have always tried to provide a balanced mix of music, so we probably play a little more gold from the past 10-15 years than most stations," explains Stone. "It's a very strong country market. We spend a lot of time on local research."

"The biggest thing for us is that we're always there," adds Stone. "Even through the worst of COVID, we were live and local in our studios. We've got heritage personalities all day long." That includes 16-year station vet **Charli McKenzi** in mornings with cohost **Randy "Shotgun" Shannon**, who is on his second stint with the station (he also served as the station's only other PD until Stone took the helm in 2006). Afternoon host **Hannah Damas** came aboard in 2017.

"We are live from 5am until midnight," says Stone, who handles the midday shift. "We've got a 25-year heritage as the Country station in the market, and other competitors have come and gone. We've built [a relationship] with listeners; we call them the 'Y100 Family.'"






Country's post-Christmas rebound continued in the February 2022 PPM book (2/3/22-3/2/22). More than half of PPM stations saw share increases as total format share rose 2.9% from 326.7 to 336.1. That number is off slightly from last February's 338.2. Total cume was up 5.4% to 22,046,000, though that figure is off 3% from one year ago. **WUSN/Chicago**, which

celebrated its 40th anniversary last month, took the cume crown for the first time since December 2014. Legend: A "+" indicates a Classic Country outlet; a "^" designates co-owned Country stations in the metro; a "t" indicates a tie; and a "*" indicates a station that is a recent subscriber for which ratings were not currently available. 
