Inside CMTMAs On CBS

Following its move to CBS, the CMT Music Awards pulled 5.16 million viewers, a five-fold increase from last year's cable-based show. Country Aircheck spoke with Exec. Producer and CMT



SVP/Production, Music & Events Margaret **Comeaux** about the opportunities — and challenges — that come with a bigger platform. CD: Let's start with the move to CBS. How did that happen? **MC:** The powers that be saw this

opportunity as potentially a real win for all of us. For CMT, for CBS ... and they were right. From the word "go," we were told to put on our show, the CMT Music Awards. It's what

got us where we are and what they wanted to see. It's what they believed in. So, that's what we did. We said all right, let's do it. Let's do the CMT Music Awards and show the world what we've been doing for years, just on a bigger platform.

How did moving to CBS affect your planning process?

When you're on a new network, like anything else new, there's new teams of people to involve. Luckily, this company has bar-none the best in the business. We just had to combine our teams. Award shows are award shows, we know what we do. They're fairly predictable in the sense of ... there's a process we go through. We couldn't have asked for better partnerships.

And how did COVID protocols affect the production?

We continue to live in the world of the pandemic. But, we're lucky. There's a task force within our company that guides us through these things. Our physical production team, led by Jackie Barba and Heather Graffagnino here in Nashville keep it on the rails for us. It's an ever-evolving situation.

Speaking of COVID, how did the plan come together after co-host Kelsea Ballerini tested positive?

Her camp told us as soon as they knew, and we spent about five minutes scratching our heads. Kelsea's energy and creativity were something we didn't want to lose. John Hamlin, Leslie Fram, Patrizia Di Maria, Jason Owen and I sat down and talked through options.

Setting The Stagecoach

After two years of COVID-induced absence, the Goldenvoiceproduced Stagecoach Festival returns April 29-May 1 in Indio, CA. Goldenvoice VP/Festival Talent Stacy Vee tells Country Aircheck

what to expect when headliners **Thomas Rhett**, Carrie Underwood and Luke Combs take the stage.

"The anxiety level is zero; the excitement level is one million," says Vee. "[Our team] misses the energy, the music, walking across the field from one stage to another. We just miss being in the thick of it with each other."

Originally set for March, Stagecoach 2020 first moved to October (CAT 3/11/20)

before cancelling in June (<u>CAT 6/11/20</u>). In Feb. 2021, the festival was cancelled for a second time (<u>CAT 2/1/21</u>). "We remained turnkey ready the entire time, though, and there was never a moment we weren't ready to announce," Vee explains. "It kept us in communication with all of the artists, and I talked to agents and managers every day. That's a big reason we were able to come back this big."

With more than 70 artists spread across three days and multiple stages, Vee and her team are poised for one of their biggest events to date. "We feel it's our responsibility to keep evolving and pushing and make it better every year," she says of Goldenvoice's growth mentality. This year's new activations include bringing in **Guy Fieri** and his Stagecoach Smokehouse experience, the return of **Diplo**'s Late Night In Palomino, an air-conditioned Honkytonk Dance Hall, the first-ever Saturday edition of **Orville Peck** Late Night and **Nikki Lane**'s Stage Stop Marketplace. "Having [Guy] curate our barbecue area, cooking onsite, talking to attendees and having them sample his food – that's the dream!" says Vee. "Finding folks you wouldn't think are a fit for Stagecoach – people to bring into our family – it gives us energy, it makes me a better booker and we get to further define what Stagecoach is."

Musically, Stagecoach has come to define itself by ranging from mainstream country to Americana and bluegrass to red dirt and Southern rock. "We love to deliver the unexpected," notes Vee. Adding to this year's list of firsts is a streaming partnership with **YouTube**. "Stagecoach isn't like any other country music

An Off The Record conversation with Eric Paslay:

Honestly, having a slowdown in 2020 and 2021 was a bit of a blessing for our family in terms of time. I don't even think I realized how much I was missing my family and just how quickly Piper was growing and changing until the world stopped. I'm so glad I was there for so many of Piper's firsts that I very easily could have missed. All that said, highlights of 2022: live shows! I never stopped writing but was definitely missing the chance to play the songs for fans. I'm thrilled



to see shows booking up again, for everyone! The first time I heard myself on the radio

I was driving over that giant bridge in Tampa with my regional radio rep, [EMI Nashville Dir./Southeast Promotion] Trudie Daniell, when my very first single, "Never Really Wanted," came on WQYK. I'm pretty sure Trudie has a video of it! Thanks, Jay Roberts!

Even If It Breaks Your Barefoot Friday Night is the newest project. It was a chance for me to record all my hits that other people recorded as well as reimagine a few of the ones I released. I can guarantee you five No. 1s, including the song of the decade. How many people can say that for a brand-new release?

[My wife] Natalie has been a big part of my career from the very beginning, so I still find myself leaning on her for opinions on songs, recordings and even to come up with song ideas. We joke and call those "wife-stock!" She's easy when it comes to being involved or letting me hit the road and do my thing, because she knows the ins and outs of the music industry and helped build this.

Piper is a little harder. She's a daddy's girl and wants me home all the time. I hate leaving her, but I love coming home to her jumping up and down screaming ,"I want to hear your new song!" She used to just run to Alexa and say ,"Alexa, play songs by my daddy." That was an experience for all if you can imagine some of the songs that would start playing! "Alexa ... stop!"

My favorite song on the radio from any genre right now - and this surprises me - is "Levitating" by Dua Lipa. I cannot get that song out of my head. I actually roughed out an acoustic version that I'm planning to play on the UK tour.

NFTs are new for us, and we're still exploring what all we can and can't do with them. I want them to be like a golden ticket in some way with each having something unique about them but all giving me a chance to be closer to the fans. Some will include a tangible aspect; some will provide unique concert experiences, and some might even involve a portion of royalties.

What can radio expect from me this year? Songs. I will keep releasing music, hopefully faster and faster since there's less corporate tape as an independent artist. However, as an indie artist, I'm not expecting radio to actually play any of my music. That said, if they did, that would be incredible, and I'd be crazy grateful.

festival, but you don't know that until you come," Vee explains. "By streaming it on a platform as massive and amazing to work with as YouTube, people who may not call country their favorite genre or know much about it may see something they want to come check out." That mentality extends to Goldenvoice's recently announced Palomino Festival (July 9 in Pasadena) which Vee save extends the brand. "There's just too much good stuff in the altcountry space. Iwanted to grab a bunch of my favorites and put them on a beautiful site."

Executing both Stagecoach and the inaugural Palomino Festival in less than two months isn't the only challenge. Ever-changing COVID protocols have been top-of-mind for more than two years now. "We have a 15-year relationship with agents, managers, artists and fans in which we've always delivered a first-class experience," says Vee. "I think we have everybody's trust and have been keeping everyone updated as the situation progresses. We have a thorough Q&A page online so if anyone has any hesitation or questions, we are making information available." Vee asserts she and her team could not do what they do without the partnership they have with Country radio. "We love 'em, and we can't imagine doing the show with them," she says. "Country radio is so important to us - they're family. Anything we need to communicate, they are always there for us, and we love to take good care of them, and all of our radio stations are so wonderful to us, too."

Though Stagecoach 2022 is quickly coming into view, Vee continues to look ahead and says there are big goals and exciting surprises ahead. "I'd love to share, but I can't!" she jokes. "Needless to say, it will just keep growing, and we're going to keep everyone on their toes." Keep up with all things Stagecoach here. -Monta Vaden

Was there a crew at her house filming?

She set up all the things in her house; there was a satellite truck outside. We set up things, but we had to be very careful and keep

everyone away from her. Her band is being projected onto the backdrop in her backyard, but they went in and recorded that separately. We pieced all those layers together, but everything you saw – like wardrobe – was all her.



Were the pre-recorded performances due to the constraints of a smaller venue [Nashville Municipal Auditorium]?

We wanted to be as big as we possibly could. Moving from a two-and-a-half-hour show to three-hours gave us an opportunity to have more performances. So, we did another performance outside on Broadway live that night. We had four pre-taped performances with the other 10 in the house, [which was] max capacity.

We've had some live audience components over the last couple of years, which has been great, but it was a really amazing to see the audience in the room – bonus excitement for everybody involved.

And rain is a good thing.

Years ago, when we started doing the Broadway stage, we had to talk contingency – it's just part of it. When we start getting weather alerts before we're even close to the show, we start having the conversations. And they become a little more real as we edge towards it.

Edie Hoback leading the physical production team that battled so much. I look at those performances in a bit of awe, because you'd never know all the things that were happening in that truck and with that crew in the days leading up and the day-of. They have to be commended for making it look effortless on TV.

The artists were like, "Yeah, we're going to put on a show for this audience." It really starts there, because without them doing that, we don't have anything. From Lainey Wilson and Cole Swindell, Jason Aldean and Bryan Adams, Cody Johnson, Miranda Lambert ... they wanted to make it happen for that audience [out in the elements], and they did. When you see it and you look back at it, it's beautiful in the rain.

What are some of the standout moments for you?

Being able to have the full audience, from Keith Urban on, sent chills down my spine. Carly Pearce's performance of "Diamondback" was incredible. I've been working on this show since 2005, but when we got to [the Jimmie Allen, Monica and Little Big Town] performance, I knew where it needed to go, where we wanted to take it and what the message was. We took a lot of care to craft that with Jimmie. and it was a pretty powerful standout moment.

And what do you say about Mickey Guyton and Black Pumas? It's the best part of what I get to do. When all the conversations and preplanning come together into that, it blows me away.

What's included in the Extended Cut?

We've got four additional performances from the Broadway stage. We get a little bit more of that badass rain look in the show. And there is more surrounding the Equal Play moment. We've got a package

that nods to where we've been with Equal Play and where we're going with it. Plus, there's still more programming going on like CMT Crossroads, CMT Campfire Sessions and CMT Storytellers. It's been a busy few months around here at CMT.
