Score Settling: December & 2015 PPM

Country shares among PPM stations took a 6.2% hit from November to December 2015, compared to a 1.2% decrease over the same period last year. Overall 2015 cume was down 1.4% to 38,825,200.

On the year, Country was the third most popular format among Persons 6+ with a 7.9 share behind News/Talk (8.9) and Top 40 (8.2), according to Nielsen Audio. The format posted a 9.1 P18-34 behind Top 40 (12.4). Country was also second behind Top 40 (9.0) P25-54, posting a 7.8 on the year. Emmis WLHK (Hank FM)/Indianapolis PD Fritz Moser:

This is a nice way to finish 2015. Hank FM is up two positions from last December to No. 4 overall. We're the only Country station in the Top 10 P25-54 and are solid P18-34.

Radio Responds In Dallas

Cumulus' **KPLX & KSCS/Dallas** are doing their part to help relief with efforts following Saturday's (12/26) tornadoes, which killed 11 in the area. "We're fortunate to have one of the best meteorologists in the area working for us in **Brad Barton**," notes outgoing PD **JR Schumann**. "That morning he sent an email to management to let us know we were under an enhanced risk of severe weather. At about 5:30 that afternoon there was a tornado warning issued for Ellis County, which is directly south of Dallas County. The decision was made to go wall-to-wall coverage via News/
